- Only members of Rikkyo University (undergraduate students, graduate students, faculty and staff) can use remote access.

-V-Campus ID and password are required to use remote access.

1. What is Remote Access?

Rikkyo University supports learning and research activities by making paid contracts for a lot of online content such as online databases, e-journals, and e-books.

Online content (with some exceptions) can be accessed and used via the campus networks of both Ikebukuro and Niiza campuses (Wi-Fi and on-campus PCs).

For the contract titles, see below:

- <u>Research Tool (Online databases etc.)</u>
- <u>eResources A-Z</u> (e-journal and e-book lists) (in Japanese)

*You can also search for e-books by title on the library OPAC.

On the other hand, accessing each online content contracted by the university from outside the campus network (for example, your home PC) is called "Remote Access". Some content is contractually "non-remotely accessible". Check the contract conditions on the above Research Tool if necessary.

2. How to Set Up Remote Access

There are currently two methods of remote access to library online content.

- Proxy Connection (Pre-setting required)
 Set up on your own PC according to the procedure in the "Proxy Connection Setting Manual" below. (Contractually permitted content only)
- Proxy Connection Setting Manual
- GakuNin (No pre-setting required)
 The following content (both are e-book platforms) can be accessed off-campus with V-Campus ID/PW authentication. See each user guide for details.
